**Movement Ban Extended**

The six day movement ban on horses and equine stock will be extended by three days – to Monday, 3 September 2007 – to reduce the risk of flu being found in South Australia.

Acting Primary Industries Minister Patrick Conlon said the decision was made to protect the State's valuable racing and recreation horse industries following the devastating further outbreaks in New South Wales.
