

The following conditions apply for Glue On shoes in South Australia.

- (a) Glue On Shoes must be approved by Stewards prior to acceptance.
- (b) An application for use must be made to the Stewards by the trainer prior to declarations of acceptance for the race in which it is first intended to run the horse in Glue On shoes - as required by AR 140 B (2).
- (c) Except for horses from interstate or overseas which have been fitted with these shoes prior to arriving in South Australia, the fitting of the shoes on all horses must be performed by a farrier approved by the Stewards.
- (d) The trainer must report to the Stewards immediately of the arrival on-course to ensure that the horse shod with these shoes is inspected as soon as possible after arrival by the on-course farrier.
- (e) In the event of a shoe being cast or so damaged that it cannot be secured and needs to be removed, the Stewards may order the withdrawal of the horse from the race.
- (f) Trainers wishing to discontinue the use of the shoes must obtain permission from the Stewards prior to declarations for the race in which it is intended that the shoes will not be used - in accordance with AR 140 B (3).
