

The following provisions apply to blinkers/visors being used in jumping events.

Horses already qualified for jumping events and approved to be fitted with blinkers/visors in flat events, will be permitted to race in jumping events with blinkers/visors provided the trainer satisfies the Stewards the horse has been schooled fitted with blinkers/visors.

Horses already qualified for jumping events, but not currently approved to be fitted with blinkers/visors in flat events, will be required to school to the satisfaction of Stewards in an organised trial to obtain approval to wear blinkers/visors in jumping events.

Horses not qualified for jumping events will be required to school to the satisfaction of Stewards in an organised trial to obtain approval to wear blinkers/visors in jumping events.

If a trainer seeks and gains approval for the use of blinkers/visors a Gear Form must be lodged prior to acceptance time.

Footnote: Blinkers were permitted for use in jumping events in South Australia as from 1st February 1996
