

Barrier Blankets are permitted in South Australia under the following conditions:-

1. A Trainer must obtain the approval of the Stewards to use the blanket by having such horse perform satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.
2. If approval is given, a Stable Return notifying the additional gear must be lodged prior to Acceptance Time when the horse is next engaged.
3. The Barrier Blanket shall be of a design as approved by the Stewards.
4. The Trainer must supply the Barrier Blanket and deliver it to the Starter prior to the race.
5. Horses which have been approved to race using a Barrier Blanket shall continue to use the Barrier Blanket unless approval to discontinue its use has been given, and a Stable Return to this effect is lodged prior to Acceptance Time.
