



THOROUGHBRED RACING SA LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

MORPHETTVILLE – THURSDAY, 28 AUGUST 2008

Stewards have advised Registered Trackwork rider Clint Binnie, the urine sample provided by him after riding trackwork at Gawler on Tuesday, 1 July 2008 detected the substance *11-nor- Δ 9 – tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid (cannabis)*.

Stewards provided evidence to Clint Binnie from Dr. J. Vine, Director, Racing Analytical Services Ltd and Dr. E. Clisby, a medical expert, in relation to this sample.

After considering the evidence, Clint Binnie pleaded guilty to an offence under ARR.81A(1) in that the sample provided contained cannabis, a substance banned under ARR.81B(f). He was suspended from riding trackwork for a period effective from midnight 21 July 2008, the day on which he was stood down from riding trackwork, and to conclude at midnight on 21 October 2008; a period of three (3) months.

He was informed that under ARR.81A (4) he could only resume riding trackwork after providing a urine sample free of banned substances.
