

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Cheltenham Park Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Wednesday, 20 August 2008

Stewards: G. Loch (Chairman), J. Petzer (M), M. Santoro (HT), T. Williamson (F) & L. Smith (Stewards), D. Southgate & M. White (Deputy Stewards), Dr. P. Horridge & Dr. R. Haensel (Veterinary Surgeons).

TRACK: Dead 5

WEATHER: Fine & Cool

Rail: Out 3 metres 1400 metres to 900 metres, 5 metres remainder.

RACE 1 : BECOME A SAJC MEMBER / SABIS THREE-YEAR-OLD CLASS 1
HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BELVIDERE BABE (J. Potter), JIGGLES (T. Baker) and IZZY FOREAL (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly.

MAJESTIC BEST (A. Patterson) was slow to jump.

Near the 900 metres TAKEACHANCEONME (S. Bailey), which was inclined to lay in and away from VIABELLA (M. Neilson), was obliged to steady as that filly shifted in.

Near the 800 metres BELVIDERE BABE (J. Potter) rolled in onto MAKE ME CRY (J. Maund) tightening that filly onto BEDFORD BUTTERFLY (J. Lyon). Shortly after BEDFORD BUTTERFLY laid back, resulting in MAKE ME CRY being tightened for room and forced to steady, losing its position.

Inside the 800 metres MAJESTIC BEST (A. Patterson), which had been inclined to race greenly, was obliged to steady away from the heels of GALACTIC (P. Gatt), which rolled in.

Inside the 300 metres JIGGLES (T. Baker) rolled out onto COSMIC CHOICE (S. Price) as that filly had been inclined to lay in.

Inside the 300 metres MAKE ME CRY (J. Maund) was disappointed when attempting a run inside BEDFORD BUTTERFLY (J. Lyon), which shifted in. J. Lyon was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres VIABELLA (M. Neilson) was inclined to race greenly under pressure and shift about.

EMELVEE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TAKEACHANCEONME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the off hind fetlock. First Aid was administered.

RACE 2 : ADRIAN BRIEN CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE / SABIS FILLIES AND MARES
MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1266 metres

WAIKELE (NZ), which refused to be loaded, was withdrawn by Stewards at 12.26 pm. Mr. K. Frew, representing Mrs. H. Frew, the Trainer of WAIKELE (NZ), was advised the mare was now suspended from racing until midnight on 30 September 2008 and it would be required to load satisfactorily in two Official Barrier Trials before it can be reinstated to race.

**RACE 2 : ADRIAN BRIEN CHRYSLER JEEP DODGE / SABIS FILLIES AND MARES
MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1266 metres (Cont'd)**

AAMIRA STAR (T. Zanker) reared as the gates opened.

FINAL SKIRMISH (S. Bailey) was slow to jump.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres KIRKLISTON BELLE (J. Lyon), which had commenced to race keenly as the pace eased, was obliged to steady off the heels of TAMISRA.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres AAMIRA STAR (T. Zanker), which was reluctant to hold its position, lost ground when racing inside TRUNOBLE.

At the entrance to the straight AAMIRA STAR (T. Zanker) was obliged to steady when tightened for room by TRUNOBLE (J. Potter), which laid in.

AAMIRA STAR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. J. MacMillan, the Trainer of AAMIRA STAR, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

**RACE 3 : PANASONIC / SABIS FILLIES AND MARES MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) -
1266 metres**

BELLE ADDICTION (L. Hopwood) and HYPOXICATION (D. Robinson) were slow to jump.

Near the 800 metres, as the pace steadied, HYPOXICATION (D. Robinson) was inclined to get its head up and be ungenerous.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres BELLE ADDICTION (L. Hopwood) became held up for some distance when racing between the heels of WESTLAKE MISS (P. Gatt) and OUR OLIVIA (M. Hoppo).

Inside the 200 metres E'MINOR (J. Maund) shifted in onto JIMELLIE (J. Potter), which was tightened for room as WESTLAKE MISS (P. Gatt) to its inside commenced to race greenly and shift about.

**RACE 4 : SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES COLTS, GELDINGS AND ENTIRES MAIDEN
PLATE (Division 1) - 1266 metres**

FRESH TELL (D. Tootell) was slow to jump.

When questioned regarding his riding of LORD OF THE CASTLE in the early and middle stages of the event S. Bailey explained pre-race he had been informed that LORD OF THE CASTLE, which was having its first start, would probably show pace as it had in a recent trial. He stated that in the vicinity of the 800 metres when racing outside BETTER BOND, he had attempted to restrain his mount but as it would not respond to his efforts, he considered a better option was to allow it to stride forward. Stewards advised S. Bailey his explanation would be reported.

SHADRACH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1822 metres

HUSSTERIA (NZ) (B. Petherick) reared as the gates opened.

RACE 5 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1822 metres (Cont'd)

Shortly after the start SACRE NAZAIRE (A. Patterson) rolled out and brushed WENDY ELLEN (J. Lyon).

Near the 1000 metres SANDHILL KING (S. Price) rolled out onto LIGHT THE KNIGHT (W. Hughes), which was inconvenienced.

At the entrance to the straight, when attempting to improve, HUMAWAY (C. Lindop) rolled out and brushed HUSSTERIA (NZ) (B. Petherick) as that mare rolled in.

At the entrance to the straight, when attempting to improve, BORAT (C. Lever) shifted out and contacted LIGHT THE KNIGHT (W. Hughes), which rolled in.

Approaching the 300 metres CAPTAIN THUNDABOLT (S. Bailey) had difficulty obtaining clear ground for some distance.

Near the 300 metres SACRE NAZAIRE (A. Patterson), which was inclined to lay in, rolled in and became awkward on the heels of LIGHT THE KNIGHT.

Approaching the 200 metres WILLEGO (T. Zanker) became held up briefly when racing in restricted room between WENDY ELLEN (J. Lyon) and HUSSTERIA (NZ) (B. Petherick), which rolled out.

Near the 200 metres SIDEARM (J. Potter) was disappointed when attempting to improve inside SACRE NAZAIRE (A. Patterson), which shifted in, resulting in SIDEARM being forced to check off the heels of LIGHT THE KNIGHT (W. Hughes). A. Patterson pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under ARR.137(a) in that he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of SIDEARM and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 24 August and to conclude at midnight on Thursday, 4 September 2008; a period of four (4) meetings.

RACE 6 : COME TO ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1366 metres

On jumping away YARTERBERY (P. Gatt) knuckled severely.

At the entrance to the straight HIERONYMUS (NZ) (C. Lever) brushed with KNOCK KNOCK (A. Patterson).

L. Hopwood, the rider of JEUNE'S EDGE, reported the gelding was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

RACE 7 : TOOHEYS NEW RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1366 metres

Ms. R. Hodson, the Trainer of SERKELT, advised Stewards she would instruct Apprentice L. Hopwood to attempt to ride that gelding behind the speed in this event in order for it to finish more strongly. Ms. Hodson stated that in two recent starts on grass tracks SERKELT had lead but compounded whereas at Port Augusta it had improved its form when ridden off the pace.

DASHING DOLL (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly.

On jumping away MISS ANCESTRY (T. Zanker) shifted out and brushed AKHA VENTURE (T. Baker).

RACE 7 : TOOHEYS NEW RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1366 metres (Cont'd)

AKHA VENTURE (T. Baker) was inclined to get its head up and race ungenerously in the early stages of the race.

SERKELT (L. Hopwood) raced keenly in the early stages.

At the entrance to the straight THE OZIE BOY (M. Neve) became held up when racing between the heels of COUNTESS OF TIBA (C. Lindop) and DASHING DOLL (M. Neilson).

Approaching the 200 metres COUNTESS OF TIBA (C. Lindop) was obliged to steady off the heels of MISS ANCESTRY (T. Zanker), which shifted in.

RACE 8 : SCHWEPES RATING 4UP 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

IJUBANI (B. Petherick) was slow to jump.

Shortly after the start NOTICED (W. Hughes) rolled out onto IJUBANI (B. Petherick), which was inconvenienced.

Near the 500 metres BEAU'S GIFT (M. Neve) improved of its own accord inside the heels of STRIKES BACK and shifted in onto OAMARU ROCKET (T. Baker), which was inconvenienced.

At the entrance to the straight BEAU'S GIFT (M. Neve) became held up for some distance when racing between the heels of STRIKES BACK (C. Lindop) and EDGE OFF (M. Neilson).

Near the 300 metres INOWSKY (S. Bailey) was disappointed when beaten to a run inside STRIKES BACK (C. Lindop) by BEAU'S GIFT (M. Neve), which shifted in.

Inside the 200 metres INOWSKY (S. Bailey) was forced to steady away from the heels of STRIKES BACK (C. Lindop), which had commenced to give ground.

Inside the 100 metres W. Hughes, the rider of NOTICED, dropped his whip. W. Hughes was reprimanded and advised that future instances of carelessness may result in a penalty being imposed.

When questioned regarding his riding of INOWSKY from the 300 metres, S. Bailey explained that after being disappointed for running inside STRIKES BACK he had attempted to improve to the outside of that gelding, however, as STRIKES BACK had come back quickly at the same time his mount had commenced to improve, he was forced to steady to avoid the heels of STRIKES BACK. He stated that thereafter he had not continued to ride his mount as he felt it may have lost its action. The Stewards noted the explanation provided and reminded S. Bailey of his obligations to report events which might have impacted on the performance of a horse. S. Bailey was ordered to attend a meeting with the Apprentices' Riding Skills Panel to review his ride.

**RACE 9 : SAJC HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL RACES TOUR C,G & E MAIDEN PLATE
(Division 2) - 1266 metres**

WHAT A DAZZLER (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start STREET (A. Patterson) was obliged to steady off the heels of FAST FRANK (L. Hopwood), which shifted in.

RACE 9 : SAJC HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL RACES TOUR C,G & E MAIDEN PLATE
(Division 2) - 1266 metres (Cont'd)

From the 300 metres until the vicinity of the 200 metres CONSUME (M. Neilson) had difficulty obtaining clear ground when racing between the heels of BAD ATTITUDE (C. Lindop) and KING'S CHARGER (S. Bailey).

Inside the 300 metres MY SILVERADO (B. Petherick) was obliged to steady when tightened by FAST FRANK (L. Hopwood), which shifted in as it commenced to weaken.

From the vicinity of the 200 metres SWIPER (NZ) (P. Roff) was inclined to lay in under pressure.

GENERAL:

ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE – SATURDAY, 9 AUGUST 2008

Stewards today inquired into a complaint lodged by a Security Officer alleging that at Allan Scott Park Morphettville on Saturday, 9 August 2008 licensed trainer, Mr. L. Kennewell, had used inappropriate language towards her in the course of her duties. After considering two incident reports lodged with the SAJC and evidence heard from the officer and Mr. Kennewell, Stewards found Mr. Kennewell guilty of a charge of misconduct under Rule ARR.175(q). Mr. Kennewell was fined \$500, however, Stewards suspended \$250 of that amount on the proviso he does not breach the Rules relating to conduct within the next twelve months.
