STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge Racecourse
by the Murray Bridge Racing Club on Wednesday, 27 August 2008

TRACK: Good 3

WEATHER: Fine

Rail: Out 3 metres from the 840 metres to 430 metres.

RACE 1 : SELECT WEALTH SOLUTIONS GOLD CUP 15 OCTOBER MAIDEN PLATE
(Division 1) - 1006 metres

SPARKLING STORM (S. Bailey) and JEUNESQUE (M. Neve) jumped away awkwardly.

DEVARISO (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and brushed with SUPABET (B. Petherick).

CHERISHING (M. Neilson) raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event.

YESQUIRE (S. Price) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

Shortly after entering the straight CHERISHING (M. Neilson) shifted out to improve and brushed with CRAMMOND (J. Lyon).

B. Petherick, the rider of SUPABET, reported on return to Scale the filly had been inclined to lay out in the straight.

RACE 2 : BECOME A MURRAY BRIDGE MEMBER MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) -
1006 metres

MISS LEANTA (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted with REAL COMMUNICATION (W. Hughes), which shifted out on jumping away.

DELTA DANE (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and brushed with LANDOU (M. Hoppo).

Near the 700 metres LANDOU (M. Hoppo) was obliged to steady off the heels of ARABIA (L. Hopwood), which commenced to give ground and rolled in, resulting in LANDOU being inconvenienced for a short distance when racing on the heels of ARABIA. L. Hopwood was reprimanded and advised in future to keep her mounts on a straight course.

RACE 3 : DERMODY PETROLEUM MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1406 metres

HELLO MISSY (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto TAMISRA (L. Hopwood), making contact with that filly.

Shortly after the start CURRENCY CUGAT (C. Lever) shifted out and away from FRESH TELL (D. Tootell) and brushed with DOODLING (S. Rowley).

After jumping away awkwardly D. Tootell, the rider of FRESH TELL, lost his footing from his off side iron and regained it a short distance thereafter.

RACE 3 : DERMODY PETROLEUM MAIDEN PLATE (Division 1) - 1406 metres (Cont'd)

Near the 1000 metres HELLO MISSY (J. Potter) was obliged to be steadied and lost its position when racing in tight room to the inside of CURRENCY CUGAT (C. Lever), when this gelding was taken in slightly by WANANGARA (S. Bailey), which raced in tight room to the inside of FRESH TELL (D. Tootell), as that gelding shifted in marginally. D. Tootell was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

Racing to the 500 metres HELLO MISSY (J. Potter) was obliged to steady off the heels of THE BIG BAY BAND (M. Neilson), which rolled in.

Between the 500 metres and the 400 metres CURRENCY CUGAT (C. Lever) and DOODLING (S. Rowley) became held up for clear ground.

Racing to the 200 metres DOODLING (S. Rowley) became held up when racing behind CENTRED (M. Hoppo) and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear ground.

Over the concluding stages TAMISRA (L. Hopwood) shifted out under pressure and inconvenienced CURRENCY CUGAT (C. Lever). L. Hopwood was advised of her obligations when her mounts commence to shift ground.

RACE 4 : PATERSON BULK TRANSPORT MAIDEN PLATE (Division 2) - 1406 metres

BENSON RED (J. Lyon) and CONTROL (A. Bannister) jumped away awkwardly.

STUDENT PRINCE (J. Maund) was slow to begin, losing two to three lengths.

Shortly after the start BENSON RED (J. Lyon) shifted out and away from GUN METAL (S. Rowley), which shifted out slightly, resulting in BENSON RED tightening WEE MATE (M. Neilson) onto ROCKETTOEM (C. Lindop), and as a result WEE MATE was inconvenienced.

Racing to the 200 metres STUDENT PRINCE (J. Maund) shifted out to improve taking BENSON RED (J. Lyon) out onto UMASIDE (L. Hopwood), resulting in BENSON RED making contact with and turning the hindquarters of UMASIDE, which became unbalanced. J. Maund was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

ROCKETTOEM (C. Lindop) laid out over the concluding stages.

RACE 5 : ROLLOND TRANSPORT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2206 metres

SCRATCH 'N' TICKLE (M. Neve) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MARTIAN DUST (D. Tootell), which was tightened onto SUGIHARA (M. Vassallo), resulting in MARTIAN DUST being hampered.

AURION (D. Robinson) jumped away awkwardly.

MARTIAN DUST (D. Tootell) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and raced ungenerously in the vicinity of the 1500 metres.

Inside the 400 metres CASH ADVANCE (J. Mallyon) shifted in and brushed with CENTURA (M. Hoppo) taking that gelding in. J. Mallyon was shown the vision of the incident.

SILVER CLIP (S. Bailey) was obliged to shift out near the 200 metres to improve.

RACE 6 : T L & A L BROWNS TRANSPORT RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1606 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two to three minutes owing to LOTTO BLUES breaking through the front of its barrier stall owing to TOLDEROL TEAPARTY proving fractious when being loaded. Apprentice L. Hopwood was dislodged from LOTTO BLUES as a consequence. LOTTO BLUES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race. L. Hopwood was uninjured in the incident. Mr. G. Lesnikowski, the Trainer of TOLDEROL TEAPARTY, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding and a repetition of its behaviour may lead to stronger action being taken against it.

IRON MAKER (NZ) (B. Hoppo) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto POINTER (J. Maund).

Inside the 500 metres TOLDEROL TEAPARTY (J. Potter) became held up for clear ground for a short distance when racing behind BELLA GRANDE (J. Lyon).

LOTTO BLUES (L. Hopwood) laid out rounding the home turn and shifted out on entering the straight.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow W. Hughes, the rider of the third placegetter LOVARAJA, to view the official footage rounding the home turn and in the straight.

RACE 7 : TILLEY'S TRANSPORT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1206 metres

The start of this event was initially delayed approximately two minutes owing to MASTER YEATS and PUGADAN proving difficult to proceed to the barrier stalls. Shortly thereafter the start was again delayed approximately one minute when SPLIT'N'HIT broke through the front of its barrier stall and after being captured and returned to behind the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who passed the gelding fit to race.

ZSA ZSA GABEEL (NZ) (B. Petherick) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto CABERNET NOW (M. Hoppo).

POLDA ROCK (L. Hopwood), MASTER YEATS (J. Mallyon) and GREAT BEGINNINGS (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly.

MY STAR DANE (S. Bailey) was slow to begin.

Near the 1000 metres ZSA ZSA GABEEL (NZ) (B. Petherick) rolled out and brushed with POLDA ROCK (L. Hopwood), which got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

In the middle stages of the event GUSTINO (J. Lyon) pulled very hard and as a consequence GREAT BEGINNINGS (J. Potter), which was following, was inconvenienced inside the 800 metres when GUSTINO was restrained by its rider.

MASTER YEATS (J. Mallyon) laid out in the straight placing its rider at a disadvantage over the final 200 metres of the event.

On return to Scale S. Bailey, the rider of MY STAR DANE, reported he felt the gelding may be lame in front on pulling up. MY STAR DANE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : O'HARA TRANSPORT / SABIS F&M CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1206 metres

ELMONDO (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto RUBEVE (P. Roff).

NOT IN THE MOOD (P. Crich) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto TAKEITTOHELIMIT (T. Zanker), which was taken in onto KISS THE CASH (C. Lions), which jumped away awkwardly. At the same time FORGOTTEN DREAMS (D. Robinson) shifted out taking MSHINDAJI (L. Hopwood) out into the running line of KISS THE CASH, which had to be checked and lost its position.

Inside the 400 metres RUBEVE (P. Roff) became held up for clear ground when improving to the inside of TAOSTAR (W. Hughes), which commenced to shift in under pressure.

GRAND TITLE (B. Hoppo) laid in throughout in the straight.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres MSHINDAJI (L. Hopwood) shifted in under riding taking KISS THE CASH (C. Lions) in, resulting in ELMONDO (C. Lindop) shifting in and away from that mare. Shortly thereafter ELLIE MAE CEE (J. Lyon) laid in, tightening KISS THE CASH onto NESTA (M. Hoppo), which maintained its line, resulting in KISS THE CASH being hampered for a number of strides.

RACE 9 : BNR TRANSPORT MAIDEN PLATE - 1606 metres

FEVOLENKO (D. Tootell) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

PIATREE (P. Roff) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto WILD ABOUT HARRY (M. Neve). Shortly thereafter BERNARDO BELLE (B. Petherick) shifted out taking RAMPUR (S. Price) out onto PIATREE, which was hampered.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres ROYAL SURVIVOR (B. Claridge) was obliged to steady when LE FEVRE TERRACE (M. Hoppo) shifted out to improve.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres JAYS EDGE (W. Hughes) shifted out to improve and near the 200 metres was inconvenienced by RAMPUR (S. Price), which shifted in.
