

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Monday, 6 October 2008

TRACK: Downgraded from Good 3 to Dead 4 at 12.15 pm **WEATHER:** Overcast

RAIL: Out 2 metres 1200 metres to 400 metres, true remainder.

RACE 1 : N U W & L U C R F SUPER THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to a number of horses proving difficult to load.

MORE ALLOWANCE (S. Price) shifted out on jumping away tightening EXALTED BEAUTY (D. Carrigg) onto DUBAI SPECIAL (K. Dyson) resulting in EXALTED BEAUTY being hampered.

ZIP ROYALE (A. Herrmann), which jumped away awkwardly, initially shifted in and thereafter shifted out sharply inconveniencing TRULY GORGEOUS (M. Neilson).

MOALA BLUE (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres DUBAI SPECIAL (K. Dyson) shifted in and away from VICTORY CRY (C. Lindop) taking EXALTED BEAUTY (D. Carrigg) onto MORE ALLOWANCE (S. Price), resulting in EXALTED BEAUTY and MORE ALLOWANCE being inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres EXALTED BEAUTY (D. Carrigg) shifted out and inconvenienced TRULY GORGEOUS (M. Neilson). D. Carrigg was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

Near the 700 metres FINE SPIRIT (A. Patterson) was momentarily inconvenienced when GOLDSTINGER (B. Petherick) laid in and shifted in for a number of strides.

ZIP ROYALE (A. Herrmann) raced very wide rounding the home turn and into the straight.

Shortly after entering the straight PUSHFUL (M. Neve) shifted in under riding taking LINDERA (D. Robinson) in onto MORE ALLOWANCE (S. Price) inconveniencing both these runners. As a consequence EXALTED BEAUTY (D. Carrigg), which was following became held up and was obliged to alter course to the inside of MORE ALLOWANCE to obtain clear running. Thereafter MORE ALLOWANCE had difficulty obtaining clear ground for some distance. M. Neve was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres TRULY GORGEOUS (M. Neilson) shifted out to improve and in doing so crossed the running of DUBAI SPECIAL (K. Dyson) resulting in K. Dyson having to take hold of her mount to avoid the heels of TRULY GORGEOUS. M. Neilson pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under ARR.137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 11 October and to conclude at midnight on Saturday, 18 October 2008; a period of four (4) race meetings.

Near the 100 metres MORE ALLOWANCE (S. Price) became momentarily held up when FINE SPIRIT (A. Patterson) shifted in.

RACE 1 : N U W & L U C R F SUPER THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres
(Cont'd)

Just prior to the line LINDERA (D. Robinson) shifted out and inconvenienced TRULY GORGEOUS (M. Neilson).

CHAMPAGNE SISTERS and VICTORY CRY were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : S A UNIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

MONDE AVION (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly.

AKHAMINE (C. Lindop), which laid in shortly after jumping away, shifted in and hampered PIPELINER (P. Gatt).

REGAL JOURNEY (C. Lever) raced keenly in the early stages of the event and raced three wide without cover for some distance.

AKHAMINE (C. Lindop) laid in throughout in the straight.

BLEVOLA MISS (M. Neilson) shifted out over the concluding stages taking MONDE AVION (A. Patterson) wider.

M. Neilson, the rider of BLEVOLA MISS, reported on return to Scale that his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

AKHAMINE suffered a minor wound to the outer heel of its near hind leg. First Aid was administered.

RACE 3 : CBUS BUILDING SUPER MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

YESQUIRE (R. Plumb) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced SHADRACH (C. Lever).

BOOGI ON THE GRASS (NZ) (S. Price) and PRINCE TO KING (K. Dyson) came together at the start and contacted.

PRINCE TO KING (K. Dyson), DARK DIVA (NZ) (J. Lyon) and MYSTIC FOX (P. Roff) all raced very keenly in the early stages of the event resulting in PRINCE TO KING (K. Dyson) becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BOOGI ON THE GRASS (NZ) (S. Price) for a short distance.

DARK DIVA (NZ) (J. Lyon) laid out from the 700 metres until approximately the 600 metres.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres PRINCE TO KING (K. Dyson) had to be steadied when MYSTIC FOX (P. Roff) commenced to give ground and rolled in.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres DARK DIVA (NZ) (J. Lyon) was obliged to steady when racing in tight room between JEUNE'S LAGOON (J. Potter) and BOOGI ON THE GRASS (NZ) (S. Price).

PAS DE POET and MYSTIC FOX were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : CBUS BUILDING SUPER MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres (Cont'd)

DARK DIVA (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. B. Dunn, the Trainer of DARK DIVA (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

Mr. J. MacMillan, the Trainer of PAS DE POET, reported to Stewards the mare returned to Scale with her tongue over the bit.

RACE 4 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE RATING 0 – 81 HANDICAP - 2007 metres

After being loaded into its barrier stall TOLDEROL TEAPARTY reared and sat down. TOLDEROL TEAPARTY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to its gum and passed the gelding fit to race. Mr. G. Lesnikowski, the Trainer of TOLDEROL TEAPARTY, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

KENWICK (M. Neilson) was hampered at the start when tightened between TOKEN PROMISE (J. Lyon) and WILLEGO (T. Zanker), which both shifted ground. As a consequence KENWICK lost its position.

MAN OF CLASS (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted HUMAWAY (C. Lindop).

LIGHTNING LILLY (P. Marks) and WENDY ELLEN (S. Price) brushed at the start.

Racing to the 1600 metres WENDY ELLEN (S. Price), when being restrained when racing inside the heels of TOKEN PROMISE (J. Lyon), which rolled in slightly, shifted in making contact with TOLDEROL TEAPARTY (M. Hoppo), tightening that horse onto KENWICK (M. Neilson), resulting in that gelding making contact with the inside running rail for a short distance and laying back out onto TOLDEROL TEAPARTY, resulting in further contact between TOLDEROL TEAPARTY, WENDY ELLEN and KENWICK. As a result these three horses raced in tight room for a short distance thereafter, resulting in their riders becoming unbalanced.

RACE 5 : A W U JACK WRIGHT MEMORIAL RATING 0 – 68 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

POINTER (B. Hoppo), LOTTYLIEL (T. Zanker) and BEATUS (P. Gatt) all jumped away awkwardly.

ZSA ZSA GABEEL (NZ) (K. Dyson) was slow to begin.

BEATUS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the horse to be lame in the near foreleg. Mr. J. Cornell, representing Trainer Mr. D.A. Hayes, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 6 : C F M E U PETER KAINE SUPER RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

HOMICIDE HANK (D. Tourneur) and LIGHT THE KNIGHT (A. Patterson) were both tightened for galloping room at the start between BILLY JO (M. Neilson) and CHERISHING (A. Herrmann), which both shifted ground. As a consequence LIGHT THE KNIGHT lost its position.

AREZZO (C. Lever) jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 6 : C F M E U PETER KAINE SUPER RATING 0-75 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

PLAYZONE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Mr. L. Macdonald, the Trainer of PLAYZONE, was advised the gelding was now suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with ARR.53A.

RACE 7 : A M W U PRECARIOUS WORK RATING 0 – 75 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to HENTSCHKE rearing behind the barrier stalls and dislodging its rider, D. Tootell. HENTSCHKE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race. D. Tootell was uninjured.

The start of this event was also delayed owing to AKATAK being inadvertently loaded into an incorrect barrier stall. This error was corrected by the Starter prior to the start being effected. Mr. S. Pearson, the Official Starter, was spoken to regarding this matter.

HENTSCHKE (D. Tootell) and RAS TAFARI (P. Roff) jumped away awkwardly.

ZIPPYAZ (J. Lyon) was slow to begin.

Near the 800 metres FASADINA (M. Hoppo) became awkwardly placed on the heels of BOLD MOVES (M. Neilson) for a number of strides.

BOOKER NOAH (P. Marks) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres LIGHTLY SPICED (C. Lindop) was obliged to alter course to the outside of QUEEN'S KISS (S. Price) to obtain clear ground.

RACE 8 : MARITIME SUPER CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1050 metres

Shortly after the start SPECULATE (J. Potter) shifted in onto DINKY DANIKA (C. Lindop) taking that mare in onto HAWKSTER (D. Tourneur) resulting in these two horses making contact and HAWKSTER brushing with ALADAH (K. Dyson) to its inside.

Shortly after jumping away MORPENNY MISS (J. Lyon) shifted out and inconvenienced ALLDRESSEDINBLACK (NZ) (A. Patterson).

C. Lindop, the rider of DINKY DANIKA, reported on return to Scale the mare felt very awkward in its action and never travelled well throughout the event and she became concerned and was unable to place the mare in the race in the early stages. DINKY DANIKA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Potter, the rider of SPECULATE, was questioned regarding the gelding racing very wide throughout the event without cover. J. Potter explained that shortly after jumping away he found himself racing to the outside of DINKY DANIKA (C. Lindop) and it was his intention to follow this mare in and take cover behind it but DINKY DANIKA continued to race wide and appeared to lay out. At the same time he was of the view that his mount was inclined to lay in and for that reason he was reluctant to push forward to cross DINKY DANIKA and as that mare did not take up a position closer to the field, he was obliged to race to its outside and wide without cover until rounding the home turn.

JOCKEY SAMPLING:

Apprentice Jockey K. Dyson and Jockey P. Marks provided urine samples.

PRE RACE TESTING:

Blood Samples were taken from the following horses for the purpose of TCO₂ testing:

- Race 2 HI WAY BABE, HOT PURSUIT and BULLION MANSION.
 - Race 3 CORPORATE SHAKER, YESQUIRE and DARK DIVA (NZ).
 - Race 4 LIGHTNING LILLY, MAN OF CLASS and WILLEGO.
 - Race 6 BELLA GRANDE, ZAZZLE and CHERISHING.
