

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Allan Scott Park Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 13 September 2008

RAIL: Normal

RACE 1 : CHANNEL 9 HURDLE - 3200 metres

On jumping the hurdle near the 800 metres on the final occasion, CASH ADVANCE (G Bedggood) landed awkwardly and stumbled badly, nearly dislodging its rider. CASH ADVANCE, which was eased out of the event at the entrance to the straight on the final occasion, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr J A O'Connor, the Trainer of CASH ADVANCE, was advised the gelding would now be required to complete a satisfactory jumping trial before accepting for any future jumping event.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres ROMMELS GOLD (NZ) (K Kawakami) became held up for clear running when racing behind JEUNE'S EDGE (A Trinder), which had commenced to give ground. As a consequence RUDE 'N' ABRUPT (P Hamblin), which was following, became held up for a short distance.

JEUNE'S EDGE, which was eased out of the event at the entrance to the straight on the final occasion, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr J Smith, the Trainer of JEUNE'S EDGE, was advised the gelding would now be required to complete a satisfactory jumping trial before accepting for any future jumping event.

HAMISH THE BRAVE, which was eased out of the event at the entrance to the straight on the final occasion, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr D Pannell, the Trainer of HAMISH THE BRAVE, was advised the gelding would now be required to complete a satisfactory jumping trial before accepting for any future jumping event.

A Lechmere, the rider of MEPHISTOPHELES, reported that after pulling up the gelding felt awkward in its action. MEPHISTOPHELES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had sustained a minor wound to the off fore coronet.

RACE 2 : ALLAN SCOTT PARK MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MISS ANCESTRY (T Zanker) jumped away awkwardly.

Prior to entering the straight ROUGH CHANCE (S Price) shifted out to improve and brushed with THE GEM (C Lever).

SPARKLING XAAR (A Herrmann) became held up for clear running shortly after entering the straight when racing behind THE GEM (C Lever) and was obliged to alter course to the inside of that mare near the 200 metres. Thereafter SPARKLING XAAR was disappointed for clear running over the concluding stages of the event.

RACE 3 : CFMEU HANDICAP - 2000 metres

VICELLO (NZ) (M Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto OMYTONE (J Benbow) resulting in HUMAWAY (D Robinson) shifting out and away from that gelding.

IRON MAKER (NZ) (B Hoppo) was slow to jump.

Approaching the 200 metres STEEL MY HEART (A Patterson) had difficulty obtaining clear running when trying to improve into a run between HUMAWAY (D Robinson) to its inside and OMYTONE (J Benbow) to its outside and thereafter near the 150 metres, was hampered for a short distance when OMYTONE shifted in under pressure.

KEEPTHEDREAMALIVE (W Hughes) laid in throughout in the straight.

RACE 4 : LINDSAY PARK GUINEAS - 1600 metres

MISS SCARLATTI (NZ) (D Tourneur), which jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted VALMIERA (A Patterson).

Racing to the 1200 metres HYPOXICATION (A Herrmann), which had raced keenly up to that point, when being restrained got its head up, raced very ungenerously for a short distance, shifted in and as a result tightened SANDQUILL (J Potter) onto MISS SCARLATTI (NZ) (D Tourneur) resulting in MISS SCARLATTI (NZ) having to be checked and lose its position.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres SANDQUILL (J Potter) shifted out to improve and brushed with SPARKS FLY (M Payne).

In the vicinity of the 500 metres D Tourneur, the rider of MISS SCARLATTI (NZ), was obliged to restrain his mount and alter course to the outside of SANDQUILL (J Potter) and SPARKS FLY (M Payne) to obtain clear running.

S Price, the rider of MISS SORENSTAM, reported the filly got its tongue over the bit during the event. MISS SORENSTAM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be exhibiting abnormal respiratory noises. Mr P Stokes, the Trainer of MISS SORENSTAM, was advised the results of an endoscopic examination are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon prior to the filly being entered for a future trial or race.

RACE 5 : SHOPFITTINGS WAREHOUSE HANDICAP - 1100 metres

TOXIC FREE MALLEE (B Higgins), which jumped away awkwardly, shifted out, and as a result MIDNIGHT JOY (J Lyon) shifted out and away from this gelding onto SCRUBBY CREEK (D Robinson), which was hampered.

M Neve, the rider of READY MADE, reported on return to scale that her mount was inclined to lay out rounding the home-turn.

TASSIE GOLD (J Potter) and TAOS PLEASURE (S Bailey) laid in, in the straight.

RACE 6 : MACMONT TOKYO CITY CUP - 1600 metres

Shortly after the start DOLLOPS (D. Moor) shifted in tightening VERCO ROAD (M. Neilson) onto EXALTED THOMAS (D. Carrigg) for a short distance. Thereafter approaching the 1400 metres DOLLOPS shifted in when insufficiently clear of VERCO ROAD tightening that gelding onto EXALTED THOMAS, resulting in VERCO ROAD losing its position and clipping the heels of DOLLOPS. D Moor pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under ARR.137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 17 September and to conclude at midnight on Saturday, 27 September 2008; a period of five (5) meetings.

RACE 6 : MACMONT TOKYO CITY CUP - 1600 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres LIFE TO THE FULL (P Gatt) shifted in to obtain a position outside ST TRINIANS (C Lever). At the same time P. Gatt eased the pace slightly and as a consequence ROAD WORKER (A Patterson), which was racing back and to the inside of LIFE TO THE FULL at the same time as SILENT SOPHIA (S Price) improved to its inside, clipped the heels of LIFE TO THE FULL. P Gatt was reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future.

At the entrance to the straight FOOLISH LAD (J Potter) was obliged to steady and alter course when ST TRINIANS (C Lever) shifted in. C Lever was severely reprimanded and advised to give riders the room to which they are entitled.

RACE 7 : OAKSIDE STUD W H WYLIE HANDICAP - 1100 metres

IMMORTALITY (S Price) jumped away awkwardly tightening TRAMUNTANA (D Moor) onto DISQUIET (A Patterson), turning that geldings hindquarters.

CHANGING EYES (NZ) (J Lyon) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto LA GOULUE (J Benbow) tightening that mare onto AMYJAYE POWER (D Tootell), which was hampered when tightened onto CONFECTIONER (R Plumb), which shifted out.

EL MAZE (M Payne) knuckled at the start.

Inside the 600 metres DISQUIET (A Patterson) became held up for clear running when racing behind CHANGING EYES (NZ) (J Lyon), which rolled in. As a consequence DISQUIET rolled in and inconvenienced TRAMUNTANA (D Moor).

Near the 200 metres AMYJAYE POWER (D Tootell) shifted out to improve and contacted MERLOT NOW (M Hoppo).

In the vicinity of the 150 metres WILD HERO (J Potter), when improving into a run inside TERANGO (A Herrmann) which shifted in under pressure, was obliged to steady and alter course to the outside of TERANGO to gain clear running. A Herrmann was severely reprimanded and advised to give riders the room to which they are entitled.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit C Lever, the rider of the second placegetter SOARESSA, and the mare's Trainer Mr G Kennewell, to view the official footage rounding the home-turn.

EL MAZE lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 8 : PT NOARLUNGA HOTEL HANDICAP - 1600 metres

OLD WORLDE (M Neilson) was slow to jump.

Near the 1200 metres LONDO (D Moor), which was racing keenly, got its head up when being restrained when LANE'S WAY (A Patterson) rolled in.

Inside the 500 metres OLD WORLDE (M Neilson) became held up for clear ground for a short distance and thereafter became held up near the 200 metres when improving onto the back of GENERAL BIRDWOOD (S Price).

Inside the 300 metres MAN OF CLASS (D Tourneur) was hampered when COPPER DAYS (A Herrmann) shifted out to improve. A Herrmann was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

JOCKEY SAMPLING:

Jockeys B Hoppo and B Higgins provided urine samples.
