STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse
by the Penola Racing Club on Thursday, 18 September 2008

RACE 1 : HYLAND FOX / SABIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately five minutes owing to MR ROPPONGI dislodging its rider C. Puls en route to the barriers and galloping riderless for a short distance. C. Puls was examined by the St John Ambulance personnel and passed fit to fulfil her ride. MR ROPPONGI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start.

CONTROL (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

ARTUZOV (S. Harrison) jumped away awkwardly.

Subsequent to this event, C. Puls was examined by the St John Ambulance personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

Following the running of this race maintenance work was required to be carried out on a small section on the inside of the track approximately thirty metres past the winning post. As a result Race 2 was rescheduled to commence at 1.00 pm, Race 3 at 1.28 pm and Race 4 at 1.58 pm.

RACE 2 : RADIO 5SE & STAR FM / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

ABEQUITO (J. Lyon) was slow to begin.

BILLY THE BRAT (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, making contact with GOLCONI (S. Harrison), which was tightened onto TRUNOBLE (P. Marks), which was inconvenienced.

YOUNG TEARAWAY (M. Munday) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 1000 metres YOUNG TEARAWAY (M. Munday) shifted out abruptly, hampering SEEYATUESDEE (S. Price), which was tightened onto GODAN (D. Robinson), which was taken out and had to be steadied off the heels of TO EXTREME (K. Post) resulting in GODAN losing its position.

CLUB ROYALE (K. Walters) was held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 300 metres.

Inside the 200 metres TRUNOBLE (P. Marks) shifted in to attempt a run inside TO EXTREME (K. Post), which rolled in slightly, and in doing so brushed STAR BLAST (J. Dertilis), which had shifted out to improve to the outside of SEEYATUESDEE (S. Price), resulting in STAR BLAST being taken in slightly and having to be eased off the heels of SEEYATUESDEE.

RACE 2 : RADIO 5SE & STAR FM / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

Inside the 100 metres BILLY THE BRAT (A. Patterson) rolled in slightly and inconvenienced CLUB ROYALE (K. Walters).

M. Munday, the rider of YOUNG TEARAWAY, became concerned with that gelding's action in the straight and did not ride the gelding out in his normal manner. YOUNG TEARAWAY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported shin soreness in both forelegs.

Correct Weight for this event to allow K. Walters, the rider of the third placegetter CLUB ROYALE, to view the official vision in the straight.

RACE 3 : LANDMARK – PENOLA / SABIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

SANDHILL BELLE (A. Patterson) was slow to begin.

ON THE AVENUE (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, making contact with MONEY IN PRINT (K. Walters), which was tightened onto HIGH'N'RYE (S. Price), which was hampered and taken in onto RED CURTAIN (M. Hoppo), which had its hindquarters turned in.

From the 400 metres BELLOZE (B. Claridge) became held up when racing behind RED CURTAIN (M. Hoppo) and in the vicinity of the 300 metres, shifted out to obtain clear ground and in doing so inconvenienced VISIONS OF JOHANNA (M. Walters), which was taken out onto RED RANGER (J. Lyon), which had to be steadied when tightened onto MONEY IN PRINT (K. Walters).

RED RANGER, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : MOTT FINNIS & CO RATING 0-59 HANDICAP (Division 1) - 1300 metres

MIND RACING (D. Robinson) jumped away awkwardly.

Near the 300 metres BOMBAY FLYER (M. Walters) became held up when racing inside the heels of MRS TINK (K. Walters) until the entrance to the straight.

Shortly after straightening SARABEE (J. Hill), which was racing behind BOMBAY FLYER (M. Walters), became held up on that gelding's heels for a short distance.

M. Walters, the rider of BOMBAY FLYER, advised Stewards the gelding was inclined to lay out from the 800 metres. BOMBAY FLYER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : SA LIVESTOCK RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

THORNDEE (P. Marks) was slow to begin.

JEWEL OF TULEA (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly.

DANTICKLE (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 6 : BE ACTIVE RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

LOTZA ACTION (J. Lyon) was slow to begin.

SEPTEMBER GOLD (J. Mallyon) jumped away awkwardly.

On jumping away BLACK TUX (A. Herrmann) shifted out making contact with HICONI (P. Marks).

On jumping away BOKOLO (K. Post) shifted out and made contact with SANDHILL PRIDE (A. Patterson).

Racing to the 100 metres BOKOLO (K. Post), which had commenced to shift out under riding, shifted out onto PRINCE OF ATHLONE (D. Robinson), which was forced to steady. K. Post was reminded of his obligations and advised in similar circumstances in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten sooner than he did on this occasion.

A. Herrmann, the rider of BLACK TUX, explained she had led comfortably and had travelled well in the early stages of the event. She added that when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres the horse failed to respond to her riding and she had been disappointed in how it finished off the race. BLACK TUX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : A B SPRAYING SERVICES RATING 0-81 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

On arrival at the barriers BLACKFORD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg and unfit to start. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew BLACKFORD at 3.37 pm. Mr. J. MacMillan, the Trainer of BLACKFORD, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

On jumping away ALLENBY'S MATE (J. Lyon) and GEORGIE RAE (A. Herrmann) came together and bumped.

FANCY FORCE (P. Marks) and ARTICE (K. Walters) jumped away awkwardly.

ARTICE (K. Walters) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

At the entrance to the straight ARTICE (K. Walters) shifted in abruptly and became unbalanced for a short distance.

Inside the 100 metres MISS DAEA (B. Claridge) commenced to shift in under riding, tightening ARTICE (K. Walters) onto SANDHILL PRINCE (K. Post), resulting in ARTICE having to be steadied for a short distance. B. Claridge was reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten sooner than he did on this occasion.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Post, the rider of the second placegetter SANDHILL PRINCE, and that gelding's Trainer Mr. S. Turner, and K. Walters, the rider of the third placegetter ARTICE, to view the official vision in the straight.

RACE 8 : GAMBIER EARTH MOVERS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1700 metres

On arrival at the barriers PURE VANITY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon as the gelding's rider B. Claridge was concerned with its action. PURE VANITY was passed fit to start.

RACE 8 : GAMBIER EARTH MOVERS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1700 metres (Cont'd)

INVINCIBLE DANCER (A. Patterson) was slow to begin.

WAVEFRONT (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto FULL OF BUBBLES (J. Lyon), which was hampered.

WAVEFRONT (J. Matthews) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

From the vicinity of the 600 metres INVINCIBLE DANCER (A. Patterson) was unable to obtain clear ground and became held up near the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight, when racing behind COUNTRY RUN (M. Munday).

From the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight COUNTRY RUN (M. Munday) became held up when racing behind KELIS (D. Robinson), which commenced to weaken.

J. Matthews, the rider of WAVEFRONT, was advised of his obligations under ARR.137A(2)(b)(c) in relation to the use of his whip when his horse is out of contention or showing no response.

RACE 9 : SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES RATING 0-59 HANDICAP (Division 2) - 1300 metres

HUNKA JUGAH (K. Post) jumped away awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres CUDGEE KAMAH (J. Julian) shifted in abruptly and made contact with SOPHELA (P. Marks).

Near the 400 metres CUDGEE KAMAH (J. Julian) shifted in over several strides under riding tightening MR CONTROLLER (J. Lyon) onto RICEMANIA (A. Herrmann), which was taken in, tightening BEATDEJUG (D. Robinson), which was forced to take hold and lose its position. J. Julian was severely reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to make a greater effort than he had on this occasion to keep his mounts straight.

Stewards opened an inquiry into J. Lyon's riding of MR CONTROLLER shortly after entering the straight, in particular his use of the whip in his left hand. Initial evidence was taken from J. Lyon and A. Herrmann, the rider of RICEMANIA. Stewards adjourned their inquiry to a date to be fixed.
