STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse
by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Friday, 13 December 2019

Stewards: S. Callanan (A/Chairman), A. Milne (HT) (Stewards), K. Lemay-Robbins (M) (Cadet Steward) P. Dearman (F), T. Kenny & G. Harvey (Deputy Stewards), Dr B. Agnew (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with a some give in it)

RAIL: Out 3 metre 900 metres to 400 metres, 4 metres 500 metres to winning post, two metres remainder.

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres

AHIGA (J. Chau) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres, when racing keenly, became awkwardly placed on the heels of RASHYATHERE. Raced greenly in the early part of the straight.

ARTFUL TEEPA (C. Lions) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BARB WIRE (R. Hurdle) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RASHYATHERE (G. Lo) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

INKERI (T. Pannell) - performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

MANDALA (J. Chau) - shortly after the start shifted in.

PEACE CLOUD (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly.

BLACK DIAMONDS (K. Lau) - shortly after the start was inconvenienced as MANDALA shifted in. In the vicinity of the 600 metres became awkward in its action and shifted about. Shortly after shifted in and contacted REJIGED, which was inconvenienced. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CRY OUT LOUD (C. Lions) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and found to be lame in the off foreleg. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew CRY OUT LOUD at 2.57 pm. Trainer Mr T. Jolly was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

REJIGED (E. Annells) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres was inconvenienced as BLACK DIAMONDS, which was awkward in its action, shifted in and contacted the mare. In the vicinity of the 150 metres rider accidentally dropped her whip.

RACE 3: AVIS PORT LINCOLN FLYING HANDICAP - 1210 metres

TOLSTOY (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin.

HANK'S NEPHEW (T. Voorham) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres raced in restricted room between **KINGSON** and **DEBEERSONUS**, which hung in.

DEBEERSONUS (J. Chau) - hung in throughout the event.

RUBY'S REWARD (S. Logan) - hung out rounding the home turn and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto **KINGSON**, which was obliged to be eased then raced in restricted room until the finish. Rider was reminded of her obligations in relation to allowing her mount to shift ground in the straight.

KINGSON (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be eased as **RUBY'S REWARD** shifted in and thereafter raced in restricted room to the inside of that mare for the remainder of the event.

VICTOR VICTOR (J. Potter) - shortly after the start shifted in behind runners.

RACE 4: K & K COOLING BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

ETHICAL SOLUTION (K. Crowther) - tongue-tie readjusted at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Rider explained when questioned, in relation to the filly's performance in today's event, that after having difficulty at the start to refit the tongue-tie to the filly, it may have stirred her up. She added that even though she was trapped wide without cover during the event, she felt the tempo of the race was of moderate speed and that **ETHICAL SOLUTION** was travelling well and was comfortable within itself. She stated that when asked for an effort she felt the filly had let down as she had expected and finished the race off well, she could offer no other explanation to the filly's performance.

MR TRUMAN (J. Chau) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROSIE LOUISE (E. Boyd) - in the early and middle stages of the event was awkwardly placed on the heels of **MR TRUMAN** on a number of occasions and was obliged to be restrained.

RACE 5: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1210 metres

KIROSHIMA (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLUE GRANITE (E. Annells) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Approaching the 200 metres rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to the off hind leg.

TUNGKETTA (T. Pannell) - at the start was buffeted between **BEDLOE'S ISLAND** and **DERR PHONZ**.

TOFFEE BELL (G. Lo) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was inconvenienced when racing in restricted room between **KIROSHIMA** and **BLUE GRANITE**. Approaching the 200 metres when attempting a tight run between **BEDLOE'S ISLAND** and **BLUE GRANITE**, which rolled out was obliged to shift in to obtain clear running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S ABEL (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin. Inside the 100 metres rolled out and bumped **DERR PHONZ**.

RACE 5: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION CLASS ONE HANDICAP
- 1210 metres (Cont'd)

DERR PHONZ (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inside the 100 metres bumped with HE'S ABEL, which rolled out.

RACE 6: SOUTHERN CROSS AUSTEREO BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

STORM VOYAGER (T. Pannell) - approaching the finish shifted out onto BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS, which was obliged to take hold. Rider reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future when his mounts commence to shift ground.

CALL ME HERBIE (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly shifted in taking DOWNS AFTER DARK in.

AVORA SUN (T. Voorham) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOWNS AFTER DARK (K. Bishop) - on jumping away was taken in by CALL ME HERBIE, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

FEARLESS AL (J. Chau) - jumped away awkwardly. in the vicinity of the 1000 metres got its head up when being restrained. Hung in under pressure in the straight and approaching the finish shifted in onto BUNDLE O'DIAMONDS, which was obliged to take hold at the same time as STORM VOYAGER shifted out. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take greater care in future.

BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS (E. Boyd) - approaching the finish was obliged to take hold as FEARLESS AL, which was hanging in, shifted in and STORM VOYAGER shifted out.

RACE 7: M&M GROUP BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes due to the late arrival of horses to the barriers.

EYE THE WORLD (G. Lo) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres became awkward on the heels of EMOJI for a short distance.

GALAXY FALLS (R. Hurdle) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

GOTTABITON (T. Pannell) - rider reported in relation to the gelding's performance that when placed under pressure at the top of the straight, failed to let down and was disappointing in its efforts to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EMOJI (K. Bishop) - Stewards questioned rider in relation to her riding of the gelding over the concluding stages, she advised that the gelding was weakening as it has led at a good tempo during the event and that she felt her actions had not effected the placings. Stewards noted K. Bishop's explanation and she was reminded of her obligations under AR131(b) and advised to ensure she rode her mounts out hands and heels to the finish in future.

DON'T DISMISS (J. Potter) - over-raced throughout the event.

OBLIQUE LINE (S. Logan) - shortly after the start shifted in behind runners. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

RACE 8: IMPACT SIGNS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

TINTAGEL ROCKER (J. Chau) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 8: IMPACT SIGNS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

MONTRE (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted ZOFFAY MAGIC. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZOFFAY MAGIC (E. Annells) - on jumping away contacted MONTRE. Shortly after had its hindquarters turned by that gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPIRIT FORCE (L. Neindorf) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

LICORICE BULLET (G. Lo) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.
