Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln
Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on
Friday, 10 December 2021

RACE 1: JACOB COLLINS 21ST THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately 30 minutes until 3.10 pm owing to BLOOMIN' JOHNNNEY becoming cast and requiring veterinary attention to be released from the barriers. All horses were returned to the mounting yard and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon.

BLOOMIN' JOHNNNEY (C. Lions) - reared and became cast in the barrier after begin loaded. Required veterinary attention to be released from the barriers. BLOOMIN' JOHNNNEY was a late scratching at 2.42 pm. Trainer, Mr D. Courtney, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start. Mr Courtney was further advised that BLOOMIN' JOHNNNEY was now required to complete and Official Barrier Trial to the Stewards' satisfaction prior to a future race start. C. Lions was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

ROKUN (F. Atkinson) - slow to begin. Jumped a patch of grass approaching the winning post and became unbalanced.

SO SILENT (A. Chung) - raced greenly in the early stages. Laid out rounding the home turn and when placed under pressure in the straight.

THIS ONE DAD (C. Jones) - slow to begin.

FREE STANCE (C. Murray) - kicked by BLOOMIN' JOHNNNEY, which was in an adjoining stall. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew FREE STANCE at 3.00 pm. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future race start.

KURIMUZON (T. Voorham) - laid out rounding the home turn and in the straight. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(b) to ride her mounts out fully to the finish.



RACE 1: JACOB COLLINS 21ST THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 Metres (cont'd)

ROWDY DIVA (K. Sardelic) – jumped away awkwardly and lost ground. Near the 500 metres lost its off side winker. Laid out in the straight.

SMART ACE (K. Zechner) – acting on a request from trainer, Mr M. Kluske, who brought the filly to races today on behalf of its trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, SMART ACE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival on course. SMART ACE was a late scratching by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice at 2.00 pm due to a swelling on the off side of the filly's neck. Stewards took evidence via telephone from Mr Hickmott. An inquiry was adjourned relative to the condition of the filly when presented on course and also as to why Mr Hickmott had not submitted a letter of authority for Mr Kluske to saddle up the filly, as well as failing to have her Thoroughbred Identification Card available as required. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

ZAKYBREE (E. Annells) – raced wide without cover throughout. Taken wider rounding the home turn.

RACE 2: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS MAIDEN PLATE – 1000 Metres

This event was rescheduled to start at 3.42 pm following the delay in Race 1.

PERFECT VOYAGE (C. Jones) – laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

PRESCIENT (K. Sardelic) – laid out rounding the home turn taking WIDMAIER (NZ) wider. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.

WIDMAIER (NZ) (K. Crowther) – taken wider rounding the home turn.

ALSAMENU (B. Price) – slow to begin.

CASSABELLA (A. Chung) – slow to begin.

LADY OF SPLENDOUR (K. Zechner) – slow to begin.

TERELLI (F. Atkinson) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

STRIP CLUB (T. Voorham) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Made contact with WIDMAIER (NZ) near the 300 metres when WIDMAIER (NZ) was taken out slightly by PRESCIENT, and became unbalanced.

RACE 3: CUSTOM KITCHENS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP (1) - 1210 Metres

This event was rescheduled to start at 4.12 pm.

JUSTICA (C. Jones) – jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

BONIFACE (NZ) (A. Chung) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

THE MASTER (K. Zechner) – shifted in on jumping away and bumped JOURNICA. Near the 300 metres had to be steadied off the heels of LEAVE IT TO ME, which commenced to weaken. Shifted out near the 200 metres when insufficiently clear of I'M OH SO PRETTY, which had to be steadied and alter course. Rider was reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a). Near the 50 metres had to be steadied and alter course when AVORA SUN shifted out under pressure.

JOURNICA (E. Boyd) – shifted out on jumping away and bumped THE MASTER. Laid out over the concluding stages.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (C. Murray) – had to be steadied near the 200 metres and alter course to the inside of THE MASTER, which shifted out.





RACE 3: CUSTOM KITCHENS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP (1) - 1210 Metres (cont'd)

AVORA SUN (K. Sardelic) - shifted out near the 50 metres when insufficiently clear of THE MASTER, which had to be steadied and alter course. Rider reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

AHECKSTAR (T. Voorham) - finished a distant last. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr T. Jolly, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare for being uncompetitive.

RACE 4: GORDY PETERSON MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP (2) - 1210 Metres

TIME WARRIOR (F. Atkinson) - hampered on jumping away when SOMETHING FOXY shifted out.

SIR JOHNSON (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Laid in from the 200 metres to the finish.

CELERITATE REGEM (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FREE WILMA (A. Chung) - inclined to over-race in the early stages. Passing the 800 metres was taken wider on the track when AMANI FARASI shifted out to improve. Approaching the 100 metres had to be steadied and alter course to the outside of TIME WARRIOR to continue into clear running.

AMANI FARASI (T. Voorham) - shifted out at the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Near the 1100 metres was tightened for room between SIR JOHNSON, which laid out in the early stages, and CITY JET, which shifted in and away from CELERITATE REGEM. Rider explained that it was her intention to be more forward, but after receiving tightening in the early stages of the race she allowed her mount to settle where comfortable.

CITY JET (K. Crowther) - tightened on jumping between AMANI FARASI, which shifted out, and CELERITATE REGEM, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

SOMETHING FOXY (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and hampered TIME WARRIOR.

RACE 5: CHOICES FLOORING BY KYM WOOLFORD BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1960 Metres

PAULO PACE (K. Sardelic) - approaching the winning post on the first occasion had to be steadied and shifted to the outside the heels of BURNING HARD, which crossed to the lead. Laid in approaching the 400 metres tightening the running of I'M BULLETPROOF.

WITCH KID (T. Voorham) - taken wider on the track near the 1400 metres.

AXECAPITAL (NZ) (C. Murray) - acting on a report from Steward / Compliance Officer, Mr A. Hayles, who inspected the gelding at its stable prior to being brought to the track, Stewards ordered a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start. Trainer, Mr D. Carrison, was directed to provide veterinary treatment records for AXECAPITAL (NZ) in the days leading up to this meeting. Stewards will interview Mr Carrison in relation to those records.

BURNING HARD (E. Boyd) - approaching the winning post on the first occasions crossed to the lead resulting in PAULO PACE having to be steadied and shifting to its outside. Rider was reminded of her obligations to ensure she is fully clear when shifting ground. Approaching the 1400 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of I'M BULLETPROOF, which shifted in. Approaching the 400 metres had to be checked away from the heels of I'M BULLETPROOF.

I'M BULLETPROOF (K. Crowther) - shifted in passing the 1400 metres when insufficiently clear of BURNING HARD, which had to be steadied. Rider reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a). Approaching the 400 metres had to be checked when tightened for room by PAULO PACE, which laid in despite the efforts of its rider.





RACE 5: CHOICES FLOORING BY KYM WOOLFORD BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1960 Metres (cont'd)

OBLIQUE LINE (K. Zechner) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Co-trainer, Mr J. Dunn, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

DESERT MINTY (E. Annells) - approaching the 1400 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of BURNING HARD and shifted out taking WITCH KID wider on the track.

RACE 6: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 74 HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

MY MATE SONNY (E. Boyd) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BRYAN'S BABE (K. Crowther) - Near the 150 metres bumped with MESSERSCHMITT, owing to both horses shifting ground.

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (K. Zechner) - shifted out over the concluding stages.

MESSERSCHMITT (A. Chung) - slow to begin. Near the 150 metres bumped with BRYAN'S BABE owing to both horses shifting ground.

LEONARDA (E. Annells) - raced wide throughout the event.

IT'S HUMPHREY (G. Lo) - rider reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) to ride his mounts fully to the finish.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Crowther (BRYAN'S BABE), trainer, Mr T. Montgomerie, and K. Zechner (MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ), which dead-heated for first, to view the official photo.

RACE 7: K & K COOLING BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (A. Chung) - made contact with and broke through a perimeter fence leaving the mounting enclosure. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start.

FEARLESS AL (B. Price) - fractious in its barrier after being loaded, jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

SPENCER GULF (K. Zechner) - laid in, in the straight.

TAJAVEDO (F. Atkinson) - laid out in the straight.

FIRE THUNDER (G. Lo) - raced keenly when leading in the early and middle stages.

MISTA KNOWITALL (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHUCKLES (E. Boyd) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 8: PROFAB PORT LINCOLN CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

ONEMORE MARSHALL (B. Price) - at the entrance to the straight laid in and had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SWING IT SISTER, which shifted out and away from SORRIDERE.

CHONCAPE (K. Crowther) - got its near foreleg up in the barriers after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

BRUTAL POWER (C. Murray) - shifted out rounding the home turn taking SORRIDERE wider on the track. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.



RACE 8: PROFAB PORT LINCOLN CLASS TWO HANDICAP – 1350 Metres (cont'd)

HAYZELLE (C. Jones) – at the entrance to the straight had to be steadied to avoid the heels of ONEMORE MARSHALL, and in doing so was taken wider on the track.

SWING IT SISTER (E. Boyd) – at the entrance to the straight shifted out slightly away from SORRIDERE. Approaching the finish line could not be fully tested to the finish when awkwardly placed between ONEMORE MARSHALL and SORRIDERE, which shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

SORRIDERE (A. Chung) – taken wider rounding the home turn. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider was reminded of his obligations to stop riding and correct his mounts as soon as they commenced to shift.

SHOWBAG (T. Voorham) – hung in throughout the event. Rider reported that her mount hung in throughout the event and proved difficult to ride out to the finish, resulting in her having to pull her whip through to her left hand in order to continue to ride her mount out to the finish.
