RACE 1: IRONGATE AUSTRALIA ENTRIES & GELDINGS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

FLUEY'S CHOICE (S. Logan) - on jumping away was taken in by MYOCEAN WARRIOR onto PEDIRKA.

IMPERIAL SEAL (J. Holder) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

INFANTRY MAN (S. Fawke) - difficult to load. Stable representative, Mr R. Daniel, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

MYOCEAN WARRIOR (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto FLUEY'S CHOICE, which was taken in.

PEDIRKA (A. Jordsjo) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto RITZ as PEDIRKA was taken in.

RITZ (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung out under pressure in the straight.

SCRIBNER CREEK (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped THE DEE TRAIN. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in over the concluding 100m of the event.

THE DEE TRAIN (M. Henderson) - shortly after the start bumped with SCRIBNER CREEK.

THEBIGSOSSO (C. Tootell) - slow to begin.

RACE 2: TRIMBOLI SERVICES MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

BARTY AYA (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

BEACH STREET (F. Atkinson) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

IMITATOR (R. Hurdle) - raced greenly under pressure in the straight and inside the 200m shifted out abruptly.

LAILA'S A GEM (H. Yuen) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

ONELOLLY'SENUFF (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

SALLETT (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

ZOUNORMOUS (J. Doyle) - hung out from the 400m until the finish.

RACE 3: CANDOUR ADVISORY MAIDEN PLATE - 1506 Metres

APACHE STATION (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly.

JOPHIEL (NZ) (R. Milnes) - lost both fore plates during the event.

KEMI (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover in the early stages and near the 1100m strode forward to take up a leading position.

LINES OF GLORY (J. Toeroek) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

GREY FOLLY (F. Atkinson) - slow to begin.

MOOSE RIVER (H. Yuen) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 4: RUBY TUESDAY FOUNDATION MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

AFRICARN LAD (K. Crowther) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out and away from BETTY AND LOU onto CUBAN LORD, which was inconvenienced.

CITIROC (R. Pearson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CUBAN LORD (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped QUEEN IN THE NORTH. Near the 500m was awkwardly placed on the heels of QUEEN IN THE NORTH for a number of strides. Raced greenly under pressure in the straight.

NAMADJI (T. Voorham) - rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

SAN LUCIDO (T. Pannell) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until near the 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WALLY WEST (R. Hurdle) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

CUBAN WATERS (S. Fawke) - laid out in the early part of the straight. Rider reported that the filly raced greenly throughout the event.

PLATINUM PRINCESS (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

QUEEN IN THE NORTH (J. Toeroek) - on jumping away bumped CUBAN LORD.

BETTY AND LOU (B. Price) - hung out from the 500m for the remainder of the event.





RACE 4: RUBY TUESDAY FOUNDATION MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

SCORPION KING (S. Tomlinson) - hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: ADVANCED TRANSPORT REFRIGERATION BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1706 Metres

MOTELL (R. Milnes) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover.

MASTER OF ZERPRISE (S. Payne) - near the 200m was awkwardly placed on the heels of POOL PONY and was obliged to shift out.

A TOUCH FROSTY (F. Atkinson) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m and laid in for the remainder of the event.

POOL PONY (J. Potter) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (J. Doyle) - stood flat footed as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin approximately three lengths. Co-trainer, Mr D. Moyle, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

RACE 6: JACQUI ION LAWYERS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2112 Metres

GROUP THINK (A. Livesey) - late scratching at 2.02pm by order of Stewards. Refer general.

SALUTE THE STARS (K. Crowther) - hung in under pressure in the straight and proved very difficult to ride. Trainer, Ms E. Hubbard, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLIGHT DECK (NZ) (C. Jones) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until the entrance to the straight and when attempting to shift out bumped with HOSTESS SUSIE on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COVERED CALL (R. Milnes) - when questioned in relation to the tactics adopted in this event rider explained that it was her intention to be further forward; however, given the way in which the gelding began and the formation of the field in the early stages, which appeared a strong pace to her outside, she elected to obtain cover. Trainer, Mr J. O'Connor, confirmed the instructions provided to the rider were to attempt to lead or settle on speed.

HOSTESS SUSIE (C. Murray) - at the entrance to the straight bumped with FLIGHT DECK (NZ).

LETTEMGO (D. Gillett) - raced wide without cover from near the 1200m.

RACE 7: KNIGHTSBRIDGE WEALTH MANAGEMENT RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

PLAYBOY CHARLIE (T. Voorham) - near the 100m was obliged to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels between BLUE LUNA as HATEECH rolled in slightly.

RISING LEGEND (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOSTER STREET (D. Caboche) - difficulty obtaining clear ground from near the 300m until near the 150m.

SIR TOOP (S. Tomlinson) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HATEECH (R. Milnes) - near the 100m rolled in onto PLAYBOY CHARLIE.



RACE 7: KNIGHTSBRIDGE WEALTH MANAGEMENT RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

IL DON CAVALLO (S. Payne) – acting on advice from trainer, Mr P. Nolan, that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg and would be unsuitable to race, Stewards declared IL DON CAVALLO a late scratching at 9.00am. Mr Nolan was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

INDIAN GAZELLE (K. Crowther) – held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until near the 150m. Laid out for the remainder of the event.

GENERAL:

RACE 6: JACQUI ION LAWYERS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2112 Metres

Stewards questioned Mr M. Seyers, the Trainer of GROUP THINK, as to the reasons the gelding was not presented to race at this meeting. After considering his explanation Stewards charged Mr Seyers under AR99(1)(b) in that he presented I AM THE FOX to race, instead of GROUP THINK, which had been accepted to run in Race 6. Mr Seyers pleaded guilty and after considering all the mitigating factors was fined \$1500.
