RACE 1: NORTHPOINT MURRAYLANDS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

RITZ (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin.

LITTLE CHICAGO (D. Gillett) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MAGNADAL (B. Price) - slow to begin.

AJNA CHAKRA (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SALLETT (S. Logan) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure from the entrance to the straight, and then became awkwardly placed on the heels of SHEDIDINDEED for a short distance near the 400m.

ANDAMOOKA (R. Milnes) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SHEDIDINDEED (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 2: BRIDGES EVENT CENTRE MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

COOL THE JETS (D. Tourneur) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

SIR ILLYRIAN (S. Payne) – hampered on jumping away. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out from the 800m until the entrance to the straight, and then was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

MADDISON MISS (A. Jordsjo) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SOFTLY BLACK (R. Milnes) – reared on jumping away and was slow into stride.

YIP YIP YIP (A. Livesey) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

REVOLUTION BELLE (S. Logan) – broke through its barrier after being loaded and was restrained shortly after. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and deemed suitable to start. Rider reported that the gelding became worked up after breaking through the barrier and had then raced greenly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WRITTEN SWOOSH (L. Neindorf) – shifted out on jumping away onto SIR ILLYRIAN. Laid out rounding the home turn. Rider reported that the filly had travelled well; however, had laid out rounding the home turn and then felt slightly short in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP – BOOK NOW MAIDEN PLATE - 2000 Metres

APACHE STATION (D. Caboche) – shifted in on jumping away onto GREY FOLLY. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the off hind, which was consistent with being galloped on. First aid administered. Co-trainers, Mr J. Hickmott and Ms C. Riggs, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

BONJOUR BLUE (J. Potter) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOUSEOFTHE DRAGON (NZ) (R. Milnes) – shifted out on jumping away onto GREY FOLLY. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

GREY FOLLY (D. Tourneur) – jumped away awkwardly and shortly after lost its position when tightened between HOUSEOFTHE DRAGON (NZ), which shifted out, and APACHE STATION, which shifted in.

SIP OF SODA (B. Wong) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, and was inclined to shift about.

VOILA LA VALSE (C. Tootell) – slow to begin.

RACE 4: MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

CAMBERWOOD (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VEZERE RIVER (T. Voorham) – jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHIPSON (J. Opperman) – jumped away awkwardly.

IRISH THORN (NZ) (C. Murray) – rider reported that in his opinion the gelding may have choked down during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZION'S GATE (D. Tourneur) – laid out under pressure in the straight.





RACE 4: MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

EXALTED KATE (J. Holder) - from near the 1200m until approaching the 1000m shifted in on a number of occasions towards CRIMSON VINE (NZ) prior to crossing that filly. Rider was reminded of his obligations and advised in future to ensure that he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

CRIMSON VINE (NZ) (E. Finnegan) - from near the 1200m until approaching the 1000m was inconvenienced on a number of occasions when EXALTED KATE commenced to shift in.

SUPER ALANA (NZ) (R. Milnes) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. The saddle of this filly shifted forward near the 1000m placing the rider at a significant disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

GLACIES HEART (C. Tootell) - near the 1000m had to be steadied when awkwardly placed to the inside of WHYS, which had been taken in slightly by CRIMSON VINE.

RACE 5: BAROOD STANDING FOR \$2200 AT ROSDEN PARK BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

CLASSY BANNER (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MAGIC PHANTOM (B. Wong) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IMPORTANT PRODUCT (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

STORM HUNTER (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

DASH IT (F. Atkinson) - near the 400m was disappointed when attempting a run between the heels of CLASSY BANNER and SAVILLE, and was obliged to alter course back to the inside of CLASSY BANNER to obtain clear ground.

GOLDEN AGE (D. Tourneur) - lost its near fore plate en route to the barrier and required farrier attention. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure in the straight and inside the 400m shifted out and contacted EXOPIPI, which was taken out onto FOUR WINDS.

HEADPHONES (S. Payne) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

STAR ESPRESSO (R. Pearson) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIGHTING FUND (J. Opperman) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LIANNE (J. Maund) - slow to begin and was uncompetitive throughout the event. Rider reported that the mare was reluctant to stretch out during the event despite his efforts and felt uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a cough. Trainer was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it being uncompetitive, and that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 6: SA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

HOOKED ON WEALTH (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ALPINE FUN (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DANTREE (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGIC MORRISS (T. Voorham) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 200m.



RACE 6: SA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

ONE MORE GRANDY (J. Potter) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (J. Opperman) – slow to begin. Rider explained that the mare had only travelled fairly and was disappointing when placed under pressure. He added that in his opinion it would benefit from the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: SAROA RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

DON'T DISMISS (C. Tootell) – inconvenienced near the 200m when STREET HUSTLER laid out into its running line.

MAVETTE (J. Holder) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

FIAMETTE (R. Hurdle) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Held up from the entrance to the straight until near the 100m.

NANA DULCE (S. Payne) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STREET HUSTLER (E. Finnegan) – laid out under pressure and near the 200m shifted onto DON'T DISMISS. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Ms K. Byrnes, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

BELLA SOO (D. Gillett) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SO BLUCKY (J. Eaton) – slow to begin.

OBELOS (GB) (S. Fawke) – reared on jumping away. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 150m.

LOOK FOR OPTIONS (R. Milnes) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: DEADLINE STANDING FOR \$2200 AT ROSDEN PARK BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

LOMAX (C. Murray) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MALINONG CLUB (R. Milnes) – jumped away awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 400m until approaching the finish and was not fully tested.

POCKET RAIDER (F. Atkinson) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout.

DAZZLING PROSPECT (D. Tournour) – Stewards questioned the rider in relation to him not placing the gelding under pressure until near the 200m. Rider explained that the gelding gave him the feel that it would only have a short sprint, and when asked for an effort that proved to be the case. He added that in his opinion DAZZLING PROSPECT is better suited on a firmed track.

SALUTE THE STARS (A. Jordsjo) – became fractious in its barrier after being loaded and kicked out on a number of occasions. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was found to have lacerations to its off hind leg and was unsuitable to start. Acting on this advice Stewards declared SALUTE THE STARS a late scratching at 4.16pm. Trainer, Ms E. Hubbard, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.



RACE 8: DEADLINE STANDING FOR \$2200 AT ROSDEN PARK BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

SEAFARING (NZ) (S. Logan) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used the whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was suspended for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 17 June 2023 to conclude midnight Wednesday, 21 June 2023, a period of two meetings. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Logan and noted that she used it on two occasions over the concluding 100m of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin.

MICKLEWHITE (J. Holder) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

CHARM SLINGA (NZ) (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LOVE VENUS (D. Gillett) - slow to begin.

FORAGER (J. Opperman) - jumped away awkwardly.
